# grenke Freestyle Chess Open in Karlsruhe

The winner of the A-Open qualifies for the **FIDE Freestyle Chess World Championship 2027**, and the three highest-placed female players in the A-Open qualify for the **FIDE Freestyle Chess Women's World Championship 2026**.

Registration Deadline:	All participants must confirm their participation on <b>2nd April by 17:00</b> on-site or through online check-in (even if pre-registered)! The playing venue opens at <b>15:00</b>
Format:	<b>9 Rounds Swiss System</b> , computer pairing with Swiss Chess <b>Time Control:</b> 90 minutes for the game + 30 seconds per move  A one-time <b>transfer from the grenke Chess Open to the grenke Freestyle Chess Open</b> is permitted up to Round 5. The transfer must be registered before the pairing of the respective round. Points earned in the grenke Chess Open will be carried over. Players who <b>transfer to the Freestyle A-Open</b> are <b>not eligible for prizes there</b> .  The <b>drawing of the starting position</b> for each round will take place immediately before the game begins. The use of electronic devices, any notes, sources of information or advice after the starting position has been displayed is not permitted. All players must be at their board when the starting position is revealed ( <b>default time is zero</b> ).
Rating:	All games will be rated for Freestyle ELO.

Qualification for FIDE Freestyle Chess World Championships :	<p>The <b>winner of the grenke Freestyle Chess Open (A)</b> qualifies for the <b>FIDE Freestyle Chess World Championship 2027</b>. If the winner is already qualified, the qualification place shall be awarded to the highest-placed player in the grenke Freestyle Chess Open who is not yet qualified.</p> <p>The <b>three highest-placed female players in the A-Open</b> qualify for the <b>FIDE Women's Freestyle Chess World Championship 2026</b>. Qualification is conditional upon full participation in the grenke Freestyle Chess Open (no tournament transfer).</p>

Participation:	<p>The stated <b>rating limits are binding</b>. The rating <b>at the start of the event</b> determines the group allocation. If a rating limit is exceeded after registration, the player must transfer to the corresponding higher tournament.</p> <p>For participation in the <b>A-Open</b>, it is sufficient that the required rating was achieved at least <b>once during the registration period</b>.</p>
Players without DWZ and ELO:	For players without a rating, the tournament director will decide on participation in the A-, B-, or C-Open (pre-registration required).
Prizes:	<p>All prizes are guaranteed. Each player may win only one prize (except for team prizes). In the event of a tie, Buchholz shall be used as the tiebreaker.</p> <p>For the A-Open, the main prizes are divided equally among tied players, regardless of tiebreak. If the tie extends beyond 15th place, players placed 16th or lower are not included in the prize share.</p> <p>Special prizes and rating prizes, as well as prizes in the B- and C-Opens, are not shared. Special prizes are awarded only if at least five players participate in the respective category.</p> <p>Rating prizes in the A- and B-Open are awarded based on TWZ. TWZ is the Freestyle-ELO if available, otherwise the FIDE-ELO, and if neither is available, the DWZ.</p> <p>Prize money is paid by bank transfer. Attendance at the awards ceremony is mandatory for main prize winners.</p> <p>Prize money for persons not subject to tax in Germany will be handled in accordance with the German Income Tax Act (EStG).</p>
Chess Tigers Gold Tour:	The grenke Freestyle Chess Open is part of the Chess Tigers Gold Tour, a tournament series combining competitive chess with outstanding prizes. For each full point scored at an official Gold Tour event, eligible players receive one Tiger Gold ticket. All tickets are automatically entered into the end-of-year raffle with top-tier prizes. Players exempt from the entry fee (e.g. GMS) are not eligible to
